This project, now complete, is capable of 1.8 Megawatts of electrical power and 11,500 lbs of steam per hour at 90 psi. In addition to the cogen the project involved installation of a 600 ton absorption chiller.

Marc Donovan, P.E. Union's facilities director will walk us through the technical aspects of the plant. This looks to be a very exciting tour.

Union College in Schenectady is between Union and Nott Streets. We will meet at the main parking lot (where the physical plant is) that is just in from the Nott Street entrance.
