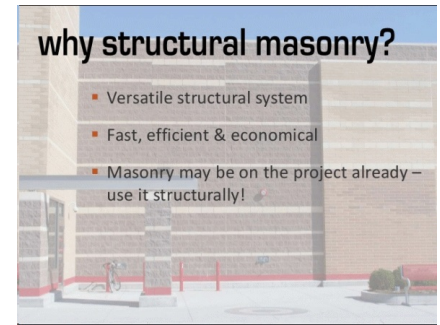


#### Keith Lashway is guest speaker

“The Benefits of Structural Masonry” is the title of the presentation at the Albany Society of Engineers dinner meeting on April 24. Keith Lashway is guest speaker.

The focus of Mr. Lashway’s presentation will be to give participants a clearer understanding of the interrelationship in masonry buildings between materials, architecture, engineering, and construction. Seemingly simple decisions can dramatically affect the building, and understanding options available in materials, design, and construction methods can result in more efficient and cost-effective structures.

Keith Lashway, PE, FNSPE, FSAME is a retired engineer who over his 40 plus year career in civil/structural engineering worked on a variety of building designs. His experience over many of these years was in the private sector working in consulting as a design engineer, project manager, and director overseeing numerous steel, concrete, precast concrete, and masonry buildings. In addition, he has over 10



years experience in the public sector working as the Director of Environmental Services, Manufacturing Assistance, and Property Redevelopment for New York State. Keith has been a member of many organizations including ACI, ASTM, ASCE, NYSSPE, SEI, and SAME. He is a graduate of Hudson Valley Community College in Architecture and University of Buffalo in Civil/Structural Engineering and is a licensed Professional Engineer in New York State.
